To whom it may concern -

Seaview HP Ltd engaged the services of Peryer Construction Wgtn Ltd to undertake the Design & Build of the new Bunnings Warehouse, 47 The Esplanade Petone. The nature of this \$7million contract was complex in its nature and extremely pressured with its 7-months construction period in order to meet client and tenant critical deadlines. The project required extensive demolition, alterations and refurbishment of the old NZ Post Te Puni Mail Centre building, involving high-level and high risk elements to the build.

I was very impressed by the stringent health & safety procedures implemented by Peryer Construction in particular their non-yielding approach by PCWL and their Site Manager, Bruce Stewart. Bruce was firmly proactive and professional in his implementation of PCWL site specific processes on this very large construction site. Site Inductions were efficient but thorough, hazard identification and controls were visible and effective.

At the peak of the project there would have been 30 sub-contract companies, and their personnel attending the site. With the huge number of workers on site this required stringent coordination and vigilance to maintain a clean and safe site. The few minor incidents that occurred were documented by PCWL with immediate action and review of the controls and procedures in place.

Under the new H&S Legislation I was obviously conscious of the strict obligations and responsibilities as a PCBU, so the few minor incidents and near misses that did occur during this project was recognition of strict health and safety measures implemented by Peryer Construction Wgtn Ltd.

Peryer Construction Wgtn Ltd delivered this high profile project to an excellent standard of workmanship across all facets of construction, health and safety and performance.
